Brighton City Council met in a Special Session on February 22, 2021. The meeting was called to order at 7 P.M. at Brighton City Hall by Mayor Melvin Rich at 100 E Washington Street, Brighton, IA.

Motion was made by Smith, seconded by C. Rich to set the Public hearing for Resolution 827, the 2021-2022 Budget. The meeting date was set for March 16, 2021 at 7 P.M. All ayes.
