A motion was made by C. Rich to give a wage increase of \$1.00 each per hour to the part-time employees effective 7/19/2021. Shelangoski seconded the motion with all ayes.

C. Rich discussed sitting in on a zoom meeting regarding the American Rescue Plan. Brighton has submitted all documentation needed for the American Rescue Plan. Jaynes moved to contact French-Reneker for an estimate on the pre-planning on the money we will receive from the funds. Smith seconded with all council in favor.

Smith motioned to approve the set public hearing for Monday, July 19th to discuss CDBG Housing Application be moved to August 2nd. Shelangoski seconded the motion with all council in favor.

Jaynes motioned that this will be the final year that the city will offer sewer discounts during filling of swimming pools. Smith seconded the motion. Ayes: 3 Nays: 2

C. Rich motioned to approve staff training for City Clerk, Michelle Talley. Seconded by Smith with all council in favor.
