 Spring Clean-up will be held May 4th, 2021

Rules are as follows:

What is accepted:

1. All loose materials contained in boxes, bags or cans with handles.
2. Bulky items such as chairs, couches, doors, carpet, windows, garage and basement cleanouts, etc.
3. Basic rule of thumb is that if 2 people can lift it, it will fit in the truck and it can be disposed of at the landfill, we will haul it away. If the item is small enough to fit in a garbage bag or can, it needs to be placed in one.

Restricted Items:

1. No tires.
2. No liquids, such as paint, oil, household cleaners or chemicals.
3. No appliances or large metal objects.
4. No yard waste.
5. Construction debris is limited to 100 lbs per residence and must come from the home it is placed in front of.
6. No TV's, computers or other electronic waste

Appliances:

Air conditioners, dehumidifiers, dishwashers, dryers, freezers, furnaces, garbage disposals, humidifiers, microwaves, refrigerators, stoves, trash compactors, washers, water heaters and water softeners.

Appliances will be picked up for \$20.00 per appliance. An appliance sticker needs to be purchased from City Hall pri- or to pick up. The sticker needs to be affixed to the appliance for which the sticker was purchased. Anybody who puts an appliance at the curb without an appliance sticker affixed, will be billed for the appliance.

The City retains the right to refuse any appliance (s) deemed to be in compacted or destroyed condition which prevents the proper removal of hazardous wastes and/or refrigerants according to law.

PUBLIC NOTICE TO NATURAL GAS CUSTOMERS

Natural gas is odorless in its natural state. We add a disagreeable smell to alert you if any should escape. Gas leaks can occur in faulty appliances, loose connections, gas line services (in and out) or from gas mains. Gas leaks can be dangerous and should be reported to the Utility at once.

IF YOU SMELL GAS- Even if your house is not equipped with gas appliances, take these precautions”

1. Leave immediately.
2. From a neighbors house call City Hall in Brighton @ 694-2695
3. between 9am and 4pm. For after hours emergency only call 911.
4. DO NOT turn electricity on or off.
5. DO NOT light matches, smoke or create any source of combustion!- Brighton Municipal Gas System

Never allow snow to completely cover your natural gas meter and/or pressure regulator set. Remove soft snow build-up gently, using only a broom or your hand.

Call Brighton Municipal Gas System @ 319-694-2695 if you notice an ice build-up on any part of the natural gas meter and/or pressure regulator set. Do not try to remove it by kicking or hitting the gas meter or piping.
