

**ORDINANCE NO. 2023-01**

**AN ORDINANCE AMENDING CHAPTER 92 OF THE CODE OF ORDINANCES OF THE CITY OF BRIGHTON, IOWA FOR THE PURPOSE OF ESTABLISHING RATES FOR WATER SERVICE FOR THE CITY OF BRIGHTON, IOWA.**

**BE IT HEREBY ORDAINED**, the Water Service rate set in the Municipal Code of the City of Brighton, Iowa, is hereby amended by deleting the same and substituting the following:

**SECTION 1. SUBSECTION AMENDED.** The Code of Ordinances of the City of Brighton, Iowa, 1997 is hereby amended by repealing Section 92.02 "Rates for Service", Ordinance 01-02, 04-01, 09-01, and 2020-01 and enacting in lieu thereof a new section to be entitled and codified to read as follows:

**Subsection 92.02 Rates for Service.** Water service shall be furnished at the following monthly rates within the City of Brighton:

| A. Gallons per month   | Rate                     |
| First 1000 gallons   | \$24.55                  |
| All over 1000 gallons  | \$ 6.08 per 1000 gallons |
| B. The Foregoing rates shall be increased by three percent (3%) each July 1. |                          |

**SECTION 2. REPEALER.** All Ordinances and parts of Ordinances in conflict with provisions of this Ordinance are hereby repealed.

**SECTION 3. SEVERABILITY CLAUSE.** If any section, provision or part of this ordinance shall be adjudged invalid or unconstitutional, such adjudication shall not affect the validity of the ordinance as a whole or any section, provision or part thereof not adjudged invalid or unconstitutional.

**SECTION 4. WHEN EFFECTIVE:** This ordinance shall be in effect with the July 15, 2023 billing after its final passage, approval and publication as provided by law.
