

ORDINANCE NO. 2023-03

AN ORDINANCE AMENDING CHAPTER 110 OF THE CODE OF ORDINANCES OF THE CITY OF BRIGHTON, IOWA FOR THE PURPOSE OF ESTABLISHING RATES FOR MUNICIPAL GASWORKS FOR THE CITY OF BRIGHTON, IOWA

BE IT HEREBY ORDAINED, the Municipal Gasworks Service rate set in the Municipal Code of the City of Brighton, Iowa, is hereby amended by deleting the same and substituting the following:

SECTION 1. RATES OF SERVICE. The monthly rate charged for natural gas supplied by the City of Brighton (Brighton Municipal Gas System) is established as set forth in this section. The rate shall vary each month based upon the average cost of gas.

1. The average cost of natural gas for the purpose of this section shall be determined on a monthly basis by computing the average cost of gas purchased by the City commencing the first day of each month through the last day of each month.
2. The following month rates shall be applied based upon the average cost of gas computed for that billing cycle.
 - a. The base price for natural gas is \$5.0343 per MCF.
 - b. An additional charge of \$10.20 per month shall be assessed for each meter.
 - c. The forgoing rates shall be increased two percent (2%) each July 1st.

SECTION 2. REPEALER. All Ordinances and parts of Ordinances in conflict with provisions of this Ordinance are hereby repealed.

SECTION 3. SEVERABILITY CLAUSE. If any section, provision, or part of this ordinance shall be adjudged invalid or unconstitutional, such adjudication shall not affect the validity of the ordinance as a whole or any section, provision, or part not adjudged invalid or unconstitutional.

SECTION 4. WHEN EFFECTIVE. This ordinance shall be in effect with the July 15, 2023 billing after its passage.
