**RESOLUTION APPROVING THE MAXIMUM TAX DOLLARS FROM
CERTAIN LEVIES FOR THE CITY'S PROPOSED FISCAL YEAR 2020-2021
BUDGET**

WHEREAS, the City Council of Brighton, Iowa is preparing the annual budget for the Fiscal Year 2020-2021; and

WHEREAS, the City Council of the City of Brighton has considered the proposed FY21 city maximum property tax dollars for the affected levy total; and

WHEREAS, a notice concerning the proposed city maximum property tax dollars was published as required and posted on the city web site as required; and

WHEREAS, a public hearing concerning the city maximum property tax dollars for the affected levy total was held at the city council meeting on February 4, 2020, at 7:00 PM at the Brighton City Hall, at 100 East Washington Street, Brighton, Iowa.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, by the City Council of the City of Brighton, Iowa, that the maximum property tax dollars for the affected tax levies for FY21 shall not exceed \$122,287, which represents an increase of greater than 102% from the maximum property tax dollars requested for FY20.





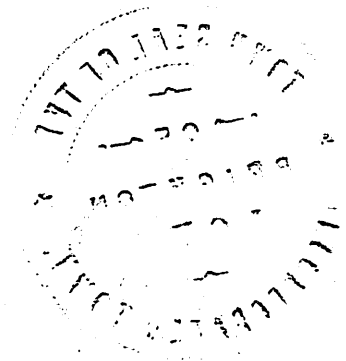
